

FAQ's for Maui Raffle

Q: Why are we doing this raffle?

A: Tucker Maxon School's mission is to help every child reach their full potential in school and in life. The school co-enrolls students who are deaf or hard of hearing with typical hearing students, and we have never turned away a family of a deaf child due to lack of ability to pay.

Q: What is the money going towards?

A: The money is going to financial aid for students who are deaf or hard of hearing.

Q: What are the odds of winning this raffle?

A: Last year we sold 1,191 tickets—the school sells a maximum of 2,000 tickets.

Q: What is our fundraising goal?

A: We would like to raise \$30,000.

Q: What does the prize include/cover?

A: The grand prize includes a week-long stay in a 2 bedroom condo at Puamana Resort in Maui (plus access to the resort's amenities), and \$1,000 cash towards airfare or other trip expenses.

Q: How many people can stay in the condo?

A: The condo can sleep up to 6 people with a queen size bed in the master bedroom, two singles in the guest bedroom, and a queen sleeper sofa in the living room.

Q: Are there any restrictions or blackout dates for travel?

A: Our school admin. team will put you in touch with our Board member, Sharon Higgins, who owns the condo. Together, you and Sharon will decide which travel dates work best for both of you. The condo is not available from Feb to early April. All other dates are negotiable. You are in charge of organizing your own travel plans/tickets. You will receive a check for \$1,000, which you can use towards your airfare, or whatever other travel expenses you choose.

Q: What amenities are included at the resort?

A: The resort has three swimming pools, including an ocean-side pool. There is also a tennis court, clubhouse, lending library, and a workout room (available for a fee). The condo itself includes 2 balconies and a charcoal grill. There is a banana tree in the backyard that may be harvested when ripe, and a shed with floats, coolers, and children toys.

Q: Is the raffle ticket price tax deductible?

A: No, the raffle ticket price is not tax deductible.
